Except otherwise stated in this Rules & Format, World Bowling Playing Rules as of September 2019 will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY

Open to all HKTBC Life Members, current (2022-2023) HKTBC paid up Members and Youth Members (Age 20 and under, **born on or after 2002**). Participants must be age 8 or above **on January 1, 2022.**

NOTE: The Government may implement a series of measures to expand the requirements of "Vaccine Pass". Please be reminded to fully comply with the updated measures implemented by both the Government and the venue.

Open Registration

Entries start from June 27 to July 15, 2022 on a first-come-first-serve basis. Office hour is Monday to Friday (except public holidays), 10:00 -18:00 (Lunch break 13:00-14:00). Entry form/s can be submitted in person at Hong Kong Tenpin Bowling Congress office at Room 2004, Olympic House, 1 Stadium Path, So Kon Po, Causeway Bay or by mail provided that entry form/s and cheque/s for entry fees are enclosed. **Cheque please make payable to "Hong Kong Tenpin Bowling Congress Ltd."**

6. DIVISIONS

The competition is divided into Open, Graded A, Graded B, U20, U15, Senior and Doubles Divisions.

a. Open Division (Men and Women Division)

Open to all bowlers.

b. Graded A Division (Men and Women Division)

Open to the following bowlers:

- i. Male bowlers whose average is 200 or under and
- ii. Female bowlers whose average is 190 or under

c. Graded B Division (Men and Women Division)

Open to the following bowlers:

- i. Male bowlers whose average is 185 or under and
- ii. Female bowlers whose average is 175 or under

*Notes for Graded A & Graded B

- i. Bowler entering these two divisions **must** produce certificate (including Chinese and English name as in ID card) with **their highest league average over a minimum of 21 games established from January 1, 2021 to July 15, 2022** issued by respective bowling centre. If the bowler did not bowl in any centres' league, then this bowler's average will be based on HKTBC's database and will be graded accordingly. Our Congress has already posted the accumulated results of the Masters Finals of tournaments that were organized by our Congress from 2021 to 2022, including the 14th Individual Open Tenpin Bowling (Local) Tournament, 2021 President Cup Tenpin Bowling Championships and 65th Festival of Sport Tenpin Bowling Competition on **HKTBC website**. In case the bowler has not participated in HKTBC's tournaments or there is no recent record of the bowler in HKTBC's database, only then will certification by the bowler's HKTBC sanctioned Bowling Club be accepted (**must be the highest average of a minimum of 21 games established in sanctioned Bowling Club's competitions from January 1, 2021 to July 15, 2022).**
- ii. **ORIGINAL** certificates must be submitted to the Tournament Office when submitting entry forms otherwise all attempts will be treated as Open Division. It is the responsibility of bowlers to see to it that it is their highest league average that they have produced.
- iii. If during any period of the tournament a bowler is found to have cheated on his/her average then the bowler will be disqualified from competing in the tournament immediately. HKTBC reserves the rights to suspend the bowlers involved.

- iv. The Men and Women Champion of the **Graded Masters A** in any **Local or International** tournaments organised by the Hong Kong Tenpin Bowling Congress from 2020 to 2022 are not eligible to bowl in **Graded A Division**. Bowlers will then need to bowl in Open Division.
- v. The Men and Women Champion of the **Potential Masters/Grade B Masters** in any **Local or International** tournaments organised by the Hong Kong Tenpin Bowling Congress from 2020 to 2022 are not eligible to bowl in **Graded B Division**. Bowlers will then need to bowl in either Graded A or Open Division.
- d. U20 Division (Boys and Girls Division)

Open to boys and girls born on or after January 1, 2002.

e. U15 Division (Mixed Boys and Girls Division)

Open to boys and girls born on or after January 1, 2007.

f. Senior Division (Mixed Men and Women Division)

Open to men and women born on or before July 21, 1972.

g. Doubles Division (Men and Women Division)

Open to all bowlers having reached the age of 13 on or before January 1, 2022.

7. EVENTS

There is no limit of attempts in the Masters Qualifying, except in Doubles Division where there is no Masters Qualifying. Masters Qualifying will be the best of two sets which must consists of **ONE set on FRESH OIL** plus **ONE set on NON-FRESH OIL**.

i. Masters Qualifying (Boys/ Girls) (best of two sets)
 ii. Masters Finals - Stage 1 (Boys/ Girls) (6 games)
 iii. Boys Quarter-finals, Semi-finals & Finals (Top 8 of Stage 1)
 iv. Girls Semi-finals & Finals (Top 4 of Stage 1)

e. U15 Division

There is no separate Masters Finals for Boys and Girls in U15 Division. Boys and Girls will bowl in the same Masters Finals. There will be an additional handicap of 5 pins per game for girls. Bowlers will receive a handicap of 5 pins per game for every year younger than 15 years of age.

*Handicap according to different age group are as follows:

Age 14: 5 pins/ game
Age 13: 10 pins/ game
Age 12: 15 pins/ game
Age 11 or below: 20 pins/ game

i. Masters Qualifyingii. Masters Finals - Stage 1(4 games)

iii. Masters Finals - Stage 2 (pins carried forward) (Top 10 of Stage 1- 2 games)

f. Senior Division

There is no separate Masters Finals for Men and Women. Men and Women will bowl in the same Masters Finals. There will be an additional handicap of 5 pins per game for women.

*Handicaps according to different age group are as follows:

Age 50 - 55: 0 pins

Age 56 or above: additional 1 pin per game for every year older

i. Masters Qualifyingii. Masters Finals(6 games)

g. Doubles Division

Each bowler is allowed only **ONE** entry in Doubles with a designate partner. There is **NO** Masters Qualifying for Doubles. Bowlers must fill in a form stating who is his/her partner and the respective Division in which each is bowling. This must be submitted before the first set of Masters Qualifying for the bowlers involved. The qualifying score is based on the final score of the Master Qualifying bowled by each bowler in his/her respective Division.

h. Challenge Cups – By invitation only

For Inter-Centre / Club / Hong Challenge Cup, all women bowlers will be given a handicap of 5 pins per game (except athletes from the Hong Kong Women National Squad and Development Squad).

In the Inter-Youth Challenge Cup, all girl bowlers will be given a handicap of 5 pins per game (except athletes from the Hong Kong National Youth Girls Squad and Development Squad).

i. Inter-Centre Challenge Cup

(Team of 3 - 3 games)

*HKTBC National Elite Senior Athletes are not allowed to participate in this event.

ii. Inter-Centre Youth Challenge Cup

(Team of 3 - 3 games)

*10 pins per game will be deducted from the score of Hong Kong National Junior Athletes and not more than 2 Hong Kong National Junior Athletes are allowed in each team. Bowlers must be born on January 1, 2002 or after.

iii. Inter-Club Challenge Cup

(Team of 3 - 3 games)

iv. Inter-Hong Challenge Cup

(Team of 3 - 3 games)

v. Sports & Recreation Challenge Cup

(Team of 3 - 3 games)

8. MASTERS FINALS

a. Open Division

The top **24 men** from the Masters Qualifying will enter the Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 6 games will be bowled. The top **8 men** from Stage 1 will then compete in the knock-out format in Quarter-finals, Semi-finals and Finals to decide the winners.

The top **12 women** from the Masters Qualifying will enter the Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 6 games will be bowled. The top **4 women** Stage 1 will then compete in the knock-out format in Semi-finals and Finals to decide the winners.

b. Graded A Division

The top **24 men** from the Masters Qualifying will enter the Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 6 games will be bowled. The top **8 men** from Stage 1 will then compete in the knock-out format in Quarter-finals, Semi-finals and Finals to decide the winners.

The top **12 women** from the Masters Qualifying will enter the Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 6 games will be bowled. The top **4 women** from Stage 1 will then compete in the knock-out format in Semi-finals and Finals to decide the winners.

c. Graded B Division

The top **18 men** from the Masters Qualifying will enter the Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 6 games will be bowled. The top **8 men** from Stage 1 will then compete in the knock-out format in Quarter-finals, Semi-finals and Finals to decide the winners.

The top **12 women** from the Masters Qualifying will enter the Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 6 games will be bowled. The top **4 women** from Stage 1 will then compete in the knock-out format in Semi-finals and Finals to decide the winners.

d. U20 Division

The top **18 boys** from the Masters Qualifying will enter the Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 6 games will be bowled. The top **8 boys** from Stage 1 will then compete in the knock-out format in Quarter-finals, Semi-finals and Finals to decide the winners.

The top **8 girls** from the Masters Qualifying will enter the Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 6 games will be bowled. The top **4 girls** from Stage 1 will then compete in the knock-out format in Semi-finals and Finals to decide the winners.

e. U15 Division (Mixed)

The top **18 boys and girls** from the Masters Qualifying will enter the Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 4 games will be bowled. The top **10 boys and girls** from Stage 1 with the total pins carried forward will enter the Masters Finals Stage 2 and another 2 games will be bowled to decide the winners.

f. Senior Division (Mixed)

The top **16 men and women** from the Masters Qualifying will enter the Masters Finals and a total of 6 games will be bowled to decide the winners.

g. Doubles Division

All the scores will be in scratch.

Baker format will be used in the Masters Finals. The top **24 men Doubles** from the Master Qualifying will enter Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 6 games will be bowled. The top **8 men Doubles** from Stage 1 will then compete in the knock-out format in Quarter-finals, Semi-finals and Finals to decide the winners.

Baker format will be used in the Masters Finals. The top **12 women Doubles** from the Master Qualifying will enter Masters Finals Stage 1 and a total of 6 games will be bowled. The top **4 women Doubles** from Stage 1 will then compete in the knock-out format in Semi-finals and Finals to decide the winners.

9. KNOCK-OUT FORMAT

a. The competition format for each knock-out match is as follows:

- i. The competition will be conducted according to a prearranged draw from seedings based on the individual bowlers or Doubles finishing position from previous stage in respective division.
- ii. The individual bowlers or Doubles shall compete in a one-game knock-out competition for respective division titles.
- iii. Individual bowlers or Doubles eliminated in each round shall be positioned based on the scores obtained in the round, with the higher score being the higher position.
- iv. Lane assignments shall be designated by the Tournament Director whose decision shall be final and binding on all Bowlers.



v. Each individual bowlers or Doubles will bowl two (2) practice throws per lane prior to the commencement of each game.

b. Baker format

Bowlers playing in the Baker format will bowl one complete frame each in turn, with the first bowler bowling in frames 1,3,5,7,9 and the second bowler bowling in frames 2,4,6,8,10. The bowler in Doubles who finishes the 10^{th} frame in each game will start first in the next game.

QUARTER-FINALS DRAW







11. ENTRIES

Game fees and entry forms are to be submitted upon purchase of entries. Entry forms can be submitted at Hong Kong Tenpin Bowling Congress office. Entry by mail with entry form/s and cheque/s for entry fees will be accepted. Bowlers are encouraged to confirm their entries by phone for mail entries. Bowler registration and entry forms must be fully filled along with the "Disclaimer and Participant Agreement". Only Cash/Cheque will be accepted upon entry in person. Please make cheque/s payable to "Hong Kong Tenpin Bowling Congress Ltd." Entry Fee once paid is non-refundable.

12. AWARDS

a. Masters Finals

Trophies will be awarded to the top three positions in the Masters Finals in all divisions and prizes will be awarded up to the positions as specified in the prize list in the various Masters Finals.

b. Challenge Cups

For Inter-Centre Challenge Cup, Inter-Centre Youth Challenge Cup, Inter-Hong Challenge Cup, Inter-Club Challenge Cup, Sports & Recreation Challenge Cup, trophies will be presented to the top three teams in each Event.

13. TIE SCORE

- a. In the case of a tie in Masters Qualifying for the last position for Masters Finals for Stage 1 in Open/Graded A/ Graded B/ U20/ Doubles Divisions, a one game roll-off shall be held. If a tie still exists, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will be held until the tie is broken.
- b. In the case of a tie in Masters Qualifying for the last position for Masters Finals for Stage 1 in U15/ Senior Divisions, a one game roll-off with handicap shall be held. If a tie still exists, a one ball roll-off will be held until the tie is broken.

The time for the roll-off will be before the start of each respective Masters Stage 1.

- c. In the case of a tie for any positions in respective Stages (except Quarter-finals, Semi-finals and Finals) of Masters Finals in respective Division, the bowler/ doubles with a lower score difference between the highest and the lowest games in the previous stage will be declared the higher position. If a tie still exists, the bowler/ doubles with a higher game in the previous stage will be declared the higher position. If a tie still exists, the bowler/ doubles with the higher last game in the previous stage will be declared the higher position.
- d. In the case of a tie in any of the matches in the Quarter-finals, Semi-finals and Finals of Open/ Graded A/ Graded B/ U20/ Doubles, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will be held until the tie is broken.
- e. If a tie exists for the bowlers/ doubles that were eliminated in the Quarter-finals, Semi-finals, bowlers/ doubles with equal scores will share the prize between them (if applicable).

14. CHECK-IN (According to the official clock)

Check-in will open **1 hour** and close **30 minutes** before the scheduled squad time in Masters Qualifying, Masters Finals unless otherwise stated. Failure to check-in **in person** for the Masters Finals, his/her placing will be allocated to the reserve who has checked in.

Bowlers must inform the check-in counter if they have consecutive squad bookings in order to exempt them from the check-in procedure for the following squad. For those who fail to check-in personally at the prescribed time, their placings as well as the fees paid will be forfeited. The vacancy will be allocated to the next pre-booked reserved bowler.

15. PROTESTS

a. Protests - Foul or Legality of Pinfall

A provisional ball or frame shall be bowled by the competitor. Tournament Committee and the official representatives of the Congress shall then solve the problem.

b. Protests - Eligibility - General Playing Rules

Protests involving eligibility or general playing rules must be made in writing to a responsible tournament official no later than 24 hours after the game in which the infraction occurred.

c. Protests – Scoring Errors

The time limit for filing protests on scoring shall be one hour from the end of the event or before the prize presentation.

16. VERIFICATION OF SCORES

It is the responsibility of each bowler to verify the correctness of scores of each game bowled by signing on the official score sheet. The score shall stand once the score sheet has been signed. Official score sheet without signature will be treated as correct and no protest can be made.

17. INCLEMENT WEATHER

In case Typhoon Signal No. 8 is hoisted 3 hours before the scheduled time of the competition or Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted 2 hours before the scheduled time of the competition, the competition will be postponed and the date will be further notified.

18. SMOKING AND DRINKING

Bowlers must not use tobacco products, consume alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol while in competition i.e., during the entire period of a block of games. In those instances where it is established that a bowler is in breach of this rule, he/she may be suspended by the Tournament Committee from the tournament for the block of games then being played. All fees paid will be forfeited.

If a bowler is caught smoking during a game, he/she will have zero pinfall for the game currently being played. If a bowler is caught smoking in between games, he/she will have zero pinfall for the succeeding game.

19. BOWLERS' ATTIRE

Only proper bowling attire (Polo shirt or crew neck T-shirt) and proper bowling shoes will be allowed during competition. Bowler in shorts, singlet, sleeveless T-shirt, jeans and any kind of hats will not be allowed to bowl. Shorts and skirts will be allowed for women bowlers. Trousers/pants for men must be of ankle-length.

In those instances where it is established that a bowler is in breach of this rule, he/she will be suspended by the Tournament Committee from the tournament for the block of games then being played and all fees paid will be forfeited.

20. DRILLING SPECIFICATIONS

According to the World Bowling Playing Rules as of September 2019 since August 2020, no balance holes are allowed. All holes drilled must be used for gripping purposes on every delivery.

A maximum of five gripping holes are allowed in a bowling ball. Any gripping hole that does not have the thumb or fingers inserted into it throughout the approach would be classified as a balance hole, which is not allowed.

21. HEALTH DECLARATION FORM

Participants must complete the **HEALTH DECLARATION FORM** on the first day of the tournament before the start of the first event. Participants will not be allowed to participate in the tournament if he/she failed to complete the form or conform with the matters as set out in the form.

All participants must fully understand and agree that he/she is healthy, physically fit and suitable to participate in this tournament. The Organizer and Co-organizer shall not be responsible for all actions, claims and demands by any person who suffers or sustains any loss, damages, injury or death arising out of, or as a result of the participant's acts due to his/her negligence. The participant undertakes to indemnify the Organizer and Co-Organizer against all actions, claims and demands by any person who suffers or sustains any loss, damages, injury or death arising out of, or as a result of the participant's acts due to his/her negligence.

22. SPECIAL NOTE

The Tournament Director reserves the right to re-allocate squad time and assigned lanes at his discretion when situation so requires. Prior notice will be given whenever possible.

A bowler failing to observe a rule(s) may be disqualified from the tournament immediately. All fees paid will be forfeited. If the offence is very serious, other penalty may be imposed on the bowler by the Tournament Committee.

The Tournament Director and the Tournament Committee reserve the right to accept or reject any entry as they see fit. Any matters arising during the Tournament which are not covered in the aforesaid information, rules and formats will be dealt with by the Tournament Director and the Tournament Committee and their decision in all cases shall be final. Meanwhile, all fees paid will not be refunded. Notwithstanding the above, an appeal may still be lodged with HKTBC within thirty days of the decision of the Tournament Committee. If dissatisfied, the last and final court of appeal shall be Asian Bowling Federation, but such appeal should be made through HKTBC in writing and a fee of US\$100 within thirty days of its decision and in accordance with the procedure specified in the World Bowling Playing Rules as of September 2019. If the appeal is upheld, the fee will be returned. Otherwise, it will be forfeited.
