RULES & FORMAT

1. ELIGIBILITY

Only Life / 2019-2020 HKTBC members are eligible.

Youth Members born on or after 1st January 1999 are eligible to bowl in the Youth Events.

2. RULES & REGULATIONS

Except otherwise stated in this Rules & Format, World Bowling Statutes and Playing Rules as of February 2019 will apply.

4. FORMAT

- a. Singles: No limit of attempts
- b. Doubles: Must change a different partner in each attempt.
- c. Youth Doubles: Youth Doubles are open to all boys and girls. All girl bowlers will be given a handicap of 10 pins per game in the Youth Doubles (except those in the Hong Kong National Youth Girls Squad and Development Squad).
- d. Men Masters: The top **18 bowlers** in the Singles Event will enter the Men Masters Final. A total of 8 games will be bowled.
- e. Women Masters: The top **12 bowlers** in the Singles Event will enter the Women Masters Final. A total of 8 games will be bowled.

- f. Youth Boys Masters: The top **12 bowlers** in the Singles Event will enter the Boys Masters Final. A total of 6 games will be bowled.
- g. Youth Girls Masters: The top **8 bowlers** in the Singles Event will enter the Girls Masters Final. A total of 6 games will be bowled.
- h. For Inter-Centre / Club Challenge Cup, all women bowlers will be given a handicap of 8 pins per game (except those in the Hong Kong Women National Squad and Development Squad). In Inter-Centre / Club Youth Challenge Cup, all girl bowlers will be given a handicap of 10 pins per game (except those in the Hong Kong National Youth Girls Squad and Development Squad).

7. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted at the office of Hong Kong Tenpin Bowling Congress during office hour (0930 - 1300; 1400 - 1800) Monday to Friday and (1000 - 1300) on Saturday on a first-come-first-serve basis. Deadline for entry is 1730 on **May 16, 2019**. Entry fee must be paid before any entry will be accepted.

10. CHECK-IN

All Bowlers should check-in **PERSONALLY ONE HOUR BEFORE** their scheduled squad time. Check-in will close **half an hour before** the scheduled squad time.

11. TIE SCORES

Whenever a tie occurs in any of the first three positions in the Singles, Doubles and Masters Events, players or team with equal scores will share the prizes between them.

a. In case of a tie in the qualifying for the last position for the Masters Event, a one game roll-off will be held. The time for the roll-off will be decided by the Tournament Committee. If a tie still exists, 9th and 10th frame will be played until the tie is broken.

12. PROTESTS

12.1 Protests - Foul or Legality of Pinfall

A provisional ball or frame shall be bowled by the competitor. Tournament Committee and the official representatives of the Congress shall then solve the problem.

12.2 Protests - Eligibility - General Playing Rules

Protests involving eligibility or general playing rules must be made in writing to a responsible tournament official no later than 24 hours after the game in which the infraction occurred. Regarding the protest of the certificate of the highest league average, if the submitted certificates were found to be false or forged, penalty would be imposed. The maximum penalty would be suspending the bowler/s from participating in any competition organized by our Congress and any competition that is sanctioned by our Congress in the coming year.

12.3 <u>Protests – Scoring Errors</u>

The time limit for filing protests on scoring shall be one hour from the end of the event <u>or before the prize presentation</u>.

13. VERIFICATION OF SCORES

It is the responsibility of each bowler to verify the correctness of scores of each game bowled by signing on the official score sheet. The score shall stand once the score sheet has been signed. Official score sheet without signature will be treated as correct and no protest can be made.

14. BOWLERS' ATTIRE

Only proper bowling uniforms (Polo Shirt or Crew neck T-shirt) and proper bowling shoes will be allowed during competition. Bowlers in shorts, singlet, sleeveless T-shirt and jeans will not be allowed to bowl. Short and skirt will be allowed for women bowlers. In those instances where it is established that a bowler is in breach of this rule, he/she may be suspended by the Tournament Committee from the tournament for the block of games then being played and all fees paid will be forfeited.

15. SMOKING AND DRINKING

The players must not use tobacco products, consume alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol while in competition; i.e. during the entire period of a block of games. In those instances where it is established that a player is in breach of this rule, he/she may be suspended by the Tournament Technical Committee from the tournament for the block of games then being played. All fees paid will be forfeited

If a bowler is caught smoking during a game he/she will have zero pinfall for the game currently being played. If a bowler is caught smoking in between games, he/she will have zero pinfall for the succeeding game.

16. INCLEMENT WEATHER

In case Typhoon Signal No. 8 is hoisted 3 hours before or Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted 2 hours before the scheduled time of the competition on the day, the competition will be postponed and the date will be further notified.

17. DISCLAIMER & PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT

All participants must <u>fully understand and agree</u> that he/she is healthy, physically fit and suitable to participate in this tournament. The Organizer and Co-organizer shall not be responsible for all actions, claims and demands by any person who suffers or sustains any loss, damages, injury or death arising out of or as a result of the participant's acts due to his/her negligence. The participant undertakes to indemnify The Organizer and Co-Organizer against all actions, claims and demands by any person who suffers or sustains any loss, damages, injury or death arising out of or as a result of the participant's acts due to his/her negligence.

All participants aged below 18 must submit the said Disclaimer and Participant Agreement signed by his/her parent or guardian.

18. <u>SPECIAL NOTE</u>

A player failing to observe a rule(s) may be disqualified from the tournament immediately. All fees paid will be forfeited, if the offence is very serious, other penalty may be imposed on the player by the Tournament committee.

The Tournament Director and the Tournament Committee reserve the right to accept or reject any entry as they see fit. Any matters arising during the Tournament which are not covered in the aforesaid information, rules and formats will be dealt with by the Tournament Director and the Tournament Committee and their decision in all cases shall be final. Meanwhile, all fees paid will not be refunded. Notwithstanding the above, an appeal may still be lodged with HKTBC within thirty days of the decision of the Tournament Committee. If dissatisfied, the last and final court of appeal shall be the Asian Bowling Federation, but such appeal should be made through HKTBC in writing and within thirty days of its decision and in accordance with the procedure specified in the World Bowling Statutes and Playing Rules as of February 2019.
