10.Transportation

Participating teams will arrive Hong Kong at the Hong Kong International Airport, which is around 80 minutes driving distance to the Championships venue, South China Athletic Association. The Venue is around 10 minutes walking distance to the Regal Hongkong Hotel, 15 minutes walking distance to The Excelsior Hong Kong, 15 minutes driving distance to City Garden Hotel/Harbour Grand Hong Kong and 20 minutes driving distance to Harbour Plaza North Point Hotel. Pick-up will be arranged for all participating teams and registered guests to and from The Excelsior Hong Kong/City Garden Hotel/Harbour Grand Hong Kong/Harbour Plaza North Point Hotel to Championships venue. Pick-up will only be arranged for all participating teams and registered guests to and from Regal Hongkong Hotel and to and from Championships Venue in case the Yellow Rain Signal/or Typhoon Signal No. 3 is on (as announced by the Hong Kong Observatory).

11. Hospital Facility

All visa applications have to be done by Hong Kong SAR Immigration Department and not through the Chinese Embassy in your country/territory. We earnestly request that all filled out forms should be email to HKTBC at least 2 months before the commencement of the championship to facilitate our processing with the HKSAR Immigration Department.

13. National Anthem and Flags

All participating federations are reminded to bring along 3 national flags (1 meter x 2 meters) and 1 CD of their national anthem which will be collected by the Secretariat upon arrival.

14.<u>Fees</u>

Entry Fee for Delegation

The 24th Asian Tenpin Bowling Championships entry fee is US\$200 per person for all players, coaches and administrators as well as any extra person in the official delegation. These fees cover accreditation card, transportation, participation in Opening Ceremony, Welcome Reception, and the Victory Banquet.

Entry Fee for Guests/ Supporters

The entry fee for guests and supporters is US\$200 per person. These fees cover accreditation card, transportation, entry into bowling venue, participation in the Opening Ceremony, Welcome Reception, **and** the Victory Banquet. Guests and supporters may reserve rooms in the official hotels subject to availability of rooms in each hotel.

Press Officials

Unless they have other duties (another capacity) related to a team or federation at the 24th Asian Tenpin Bowling Championships, there will be no entry fee for accredited press officials except for participation in the Victory Banquet. Banquet fee for press is US\$50 per person.

The qualifying criteria is to take the highest All Events scores (24 games) of the top 5 members of each Member Federation's Men's Team and Women's Team respectively in the Championships. The number of teams for the ABF is 12 men's teams and 12 women's teams.

World Games 2017

The qualifying criteria is to take the highest All Events scores (24 games) of the top 2 members of each Member Federation's Men's Team and Women's Team respectively in the Championships. The number of positions for the ABF is 5 men's teams and 5 women's teams consisting of two bowlers in each.
